National Chengchi University was relocated to Taipei in 1954. At that time, the Library was managed under the direction of the Academic Affairs Office. Then, in 1959, the Library became an independent department within the University. Over time, the Library has amassed an impressive collection of humanities and social sciences materials, and has expanded from the Main Library Building to include the new Dah Hsian Seetoo Library, as well as three branch libraries located in the General Building of Colleges, the College of Commerce, and the College of Communication.

Our library's diverse collection, dedicated staff, innovative resources, and inventive learning spaces are all focused on one goal – providing the best possible academic environment for our school community.


